Grab a couple of friends and come out for a fun day of racing at Kingston Downs, Rome, GA. You can have 2 or 4 riders on a team or choose to ride solo the entire 8 hours. The course will be 8 to 9 miles long with a little bit of everything in it. Mini course will be 3-5 miles long. PeeWees will be 1-3 miles long. New this year, we are adding a shop class. Each motorcycle shop in the area is encouraged to bring a team and compete for the shop championship.

### **RULES**

- Age is determined by age on raceday.
- An armband with the teams transponder must be carried by the racer to be scored in the scoring tent.
- All other team members and bikes must remain in the pit area at all times. Only the rider with the transponder armband can be on the course.
- Team armbands/transponders will be provided at sign-up and must be passed from rider to rider during pit stops.
- All rider changes and pit stops must be made in your designated pit area.
- Any rider towed in for repairs will not be scored for that lap. Teammates must not leave the pit area until the towed rider is back in the pits and the armband/transponder is passed to the next rider.
- Any rider can ride any bike on the team, but the team must finish with a bike that started the race. No bike substitutions.
- Awards presented to the top 5 teams in every class.
- Most everyone in the parking lot knows the difference between right and wrong. Choose right, watch your kids, no pit riding, respect the property and Have a Great Weekend!
