## **RULES**

- Up to 4 riders on a team. One bike per team member
- Teams must race in the class of youngest or fastest team member. Example: 3 50 year old riders and 1 30 year old rider- the whole team must race in the Vet (30+) class. Example 2: 3 "C" riders and 1 "A" rider- the whole team must race in an Expert class.
- An arm band with the teams number must be carried by the racer on the course to be scored in the scoring tent. Electronic scoring is used, but transponders are not necessary.
- All other team members and bikes must remain in the pit area at all times. Only the rider with the team arm band can be on the course.
- Team arm bands will be provided at sign-up and must be passed from rider to rider during pit stops.
- All rider changes and pit stops must be made in your designated pit area along pit row.
- A pit row by-pass will be available for all riders not pitting for repairs or rider changes. If a rider comes down pit row he/she must either stop for repairs or a rider change. No racing thru pit row.
- Pit row speed limit is 10 MPH all the way to the end of pit row. If you can't go 10 MPH or less, don't come to this race. Speeders will be penalized.
- Any rider towed in for repairs will not be scored for that lap.
- Any team member can ride any bike on the team, but the team must finish the race with a bike that started the race. No bike substitutions.
- No "C" or beginner rider teaming with "A " or "B" riders competing in an expert class will be forced to move up in our SORCS series. "C" or beginner riders will not be penalized for riding in a higher class with "A" or "B" teammates.
- Awards presented to the top 5 teams in every class at each race. Overall series awards will be presented to the top 5 teams in each class at our SORCS awards banquet in Jan. 2011.
- 2 riders of record must compete in all 3 races to be eligible for overall series awards. A 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> rider may be used at any of the 3 races, so long as they fall into the same class requirements. This is to allow for injuries, family obligations, vacations etc... It would be difficult to have 4 team members commit to all 3 dates. Only riders that compete in all 3 races on the same team are eligible for overall series awards. Olympic points system will be used for overall scoring.
- All other 2010 SORCS rules will be used as applicable.
