

Seasons greetings to everyone. Thanks to everyone that came out to the races this year. Our 2010 schedule is complete and we have some new things going on. Our hare scramble schedule is similar to last years with two new locations in Holland, Ga. Both locations are on the same huge farm, but with completely different parking areas and race courses. This should be a good location for us this year and in the years to come, plenty of room for an enduro some day. We will also be returning to Broad River this year with improved parking and starting areas. New this year will be our 8 hour Triple Crown Series. Our spring race will be at the David Hill Farm in Sparta, Ga, summer race at Cookson Creek Farms in Conasauga, Tn, and our fall race will be at Highpoint in Perry, Ga. All three races will feature the same format with quads racing 8 hours on Saturday, minis racing 6 hours on Saturday, and bikes running 8 hours on Sunday. All these locations are big enough to accommodate 3 seperate courses so bikes don't have to race in quad ruts on Sunday. Teams may have up to 4 riders per team, but at least 2 riders of record must compete in all 3 races to be eligible for overall series awards at the end of the year SORCS banquet. Complete 8 hour series rules and requirements will be posted soon. Also new this year, we will be having a few gran-prix motocross races. These races will consist of about 2 miles of plowed, watered, and groomed old school motocross courses. No doubles, triples, or whoop sections, but plenty of fun obstacles that anyone can enjoy on any type bike, from early 70's vintage bikes to modern bikes and quads. And last, but not least, we have a couple of winter races planned.. Our first winter race will be at Cookson Creek Farms on Jan. 24th. This hare scramble will utilize some of our existing woods trails, some new trails, and three to four miles of plowed crop land. All of our previous races at Cookson Creek we have had to dodge a lot of really fun stuff because of crops growing. Not so on Jan. 24th, all the crops are in and we can run anywhere on the property. If we can get some good weather, this should be one of the most fun hare scrambles we have ever put on. Also, to take advantage of the warmest part of the day, our normal schedule will start one hour later. Minis at 9:15 am, bikes at 11:00 am, and quads at 2:00 pm. Our second winter race will be at Beaver Dam Creek Plantation in Sparta, Ga on Feb. 14th. For lack of a better name, we are going to call this race the SORCS Funduro. No membership, drivers license, or tag required.

This event will feature a 25 to 30 mile loop run twice. The race will have transponder scoring, a normal hare scramble start, an observation check at the far end of the loop, and a 30 minute pause for gas and lunch after the first loop. The start of the second loop will be enduro style. Example: All riders coming in to the scoring tent in the 11:30 minute will start the second loop at 12:00. All riders coming in on the 11:31 minute will start the second loop at 12:01 and so on. Riders will be logged in a back-up book and tagged for the restart as they exit the scoring tent. The start of the second loop will use normal flip cards like any enduro. All riders tagged with a 12:00 restart sticker should be at the starting line a few minutes early, to be logged in a back-up book to prevent cheating, and when the card flips 12:00 you continue racing, all the while the computer scoring system is still ticking. At the end of the second loop the race is over with a checkered flag. Scoring will stay open one hour and 15 minutes after the race leader arrives (to allow for 15 rows starting one minute apart) anyone arriving after that is houred out and will not be scored for the second loop. Results will be computed like any 2 lap hare scramble. Think of it as a 2 section enduro, with the second section ending with a tie-breaker check. (2nd section will be counted to the second). The course will be a mixture of old hare scramble courses, enduro trails from our Rattler Enduros, and all the new trail we can cut between now and race day. Quads will run the majority of the course 2 laps, with the single track sections taken out, same pause for lunch and same scoring as the bikes. Minis will run an abbreviated course of about 7 miles for 3 laps, with normal hare scramble scoring- no pauses. Start times for this event will be: minis 8:15, bikes 10:00, and quads at 2:30. More details will be posted soon. We are working hard on our 2010 rulebook, if you have any suggestions or comments on the new rulebook, e-mail us eddie@sores.net.
